



TEAM CODE OF CONDUCT

We want to play in the League because playing matches is a great way to improve our skills and our understanding of the game. Plus we like competition.

When playing I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team.
- Play fairly - I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coach and manager
- Play by the rules as directed by the referee
- Be gracious in victory and defeat and will shake hands with the other team and referee
- Listen and respond to what my coach and manager tell me
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the whole team and not one individual player
- Talk to someone I trust or the welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at the club

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any or all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, manager coach, other team's coach or the referee
- Receive a formal warning from the coach
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club

In addition

- My club may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the code
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension on my club
