



TEAM TRAVEL POLICY

LIMEHOUSE LACES' POLICY REGARDING TRAVEL TO GAMES:

Home Games

- Girls are expected to arrive at the home venue 30 minutes before the start of the game. The coach or team manager will be there and will be responsible for the girls once they have arrived until the end of the game. In the event the coach or manager is delayed you can either chose to wait with your daughter until they get there, or entrust the care of your daughter to another parent.
- Once the game is finished all girls in year 7 and above will be free to leave the venue. If your daughter is in year 6 please make sure that she is collected on time. Year 6 girls will only be allowed to leave unaccompanied if we have a signed permission slip.
- In the event of injury we will follow our Emergency First Aid Procedure

Away games

- Girls are expected to be responsible for their own travel arrangements and to arrive at the away venue 30 minutes before the start of the game. The coach and/or team manager will be at the venue and will be responsible for the girls once they have arrived. In the event the coach or manager is delayed you can either chose to wait with your daughter until they get there, or entrust the care of your daughter to another parent.
- Once the game is finished - all girls in year 7 and above will be free to leave the venue. If your daughter is in year 6 please make sure that she is collected on time. Year 6 girls will only be allowed to leave unaccompanied if we have a signed permission slip.
- In the event of injury we will follow our Emergency First Aid Procedure

Parent Co-operation with Travel Arrangements

- Your team manager will help facilitate travel arrangements by putting parents in touch with each other with a view to help getting girls to and from games. However, these arrangements are viewed as being between parents and it is up to every parent to decide whether they wish to entrust their child to the care of another parent to travel to and from the venue.
- A parent who is a coach or manager is not acting in their official capacity if they travel with girls to and from games - they are acting as a parent and it is your responsibility as a parent to decide whether to entrust your child to their care.
- A coach who is not a parent may travel with the girls to games, but is not acting in their capacity as coach when they travel and your child should be under the care of another parent.
